

# Roche Report to the Community

Roche is extremely proud to watch exceptional organizations make the ON3 campus their home. As was our vision and hope, they are already contributing to the region in so many ways, from advancing health care and science in NJ to economically supporting the area's communities and businesses. Roche has used proven, effective, and pioneering technologies to clean up the former Roche Nutley site quickly and safely, and we continue to work closely with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) on our long-term groundwater remediation plan, building on the extensive work that has already been completed.

## *Update on the Environmental Remediation: May 20, 2021 - November 20, 2021*

### **Over the past six months, Roche:**

- Submitted to NJDEP an annual *Site-Wide Groundwater Progress Report*; a *Remedial Action Report* (RAR) and a *Remedial Action Permit* (RAP) application for site-wide groundwater.
- Continued delineation and initiated implementation of the *MW-28 LNAPL* (light non-aqueous phase liquid) remedial measures.
- Conducted groundwater monitoring as specified in the NJDEP-approved December 2019 *Groundwater Remedial Action Work Plan* (RAWP).
- Repaired wells within on-site redevelopment areas and closed wells no longer needed for groundwater monitoring, in accordance with regulatory guidelines.
- Continued to make information and reports available on the Roche Nutley website ([www.rocche-nutley.com](http://www.rocche-nutley.com)).

### **Over the next six months, Roche plans to:**

- Submit a *Receptor Evaluation Report* to NJDEP.
- Issue a *Response Action Outcome* (RAO) for groundwater following NJDEP approval of the RAP application and submit an annual *Site-Wide Groundwater Progress Report*.
- Continue and potentially complete remediation of the *MW-28 LNAPL* area.
- Continue to monitor groundwater in accordance with the RAWP.
- Close wells not needed for long-term monitoring, in accordance with regulatory guidelines.
- Continue to make information and reports available on the website ([www.rocche-nutley.com](http://www.rocche-nutley.com)), including the schedule for off-site groundwater sampling.
