



Roche Report to the Community

Roche has used proven technologies to clean up the former Roche Nutley site quickly and safely. The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) approved our long-term groundwater monitoring program, building on the remedial work completed over the past several years.

Update on the Environmental Remediation July 2023

Since our last update, Roche:

- Completed well monitoring of the MW-28 LNAPL (light non-aqueous phase liquid) area; submitted the Remedial Investigation Report (RIR)/Remedial Action Report (RAR) for the area to the NJDEP; and received NJDEP's approval of the MW-28 LNAPL RIR/RAR on July 12, 2023.
- Obtained a Response Action Outcome (RAO), issued by its Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP), for groundwater remediated in accordance with the NJDEP-approved Site-Wide Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP).
- Continued to monitor groundwater as specified in the Groundwater Remedial Action Permit (RAP) and repaired on-site wells, as necessary.
- Continued to make information and reports available on the Roche Nutley website, including notifications for off-site groundwater sampling.

Roche will continue its long-term groundwater monitoring in the future, consistent with its RAP, and will post updates on groundwater monitoring as well as other remedial activities on the Roche Nutley remediation website: www.roke-nutley.com
