



Roche Report to the Community

Roche has used proven, effective, and pioneering technologies to clean up the former Roche Nutley site quickly and safely, and we continue to work closely with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) on our long-term groundwater remediation plan, building on the extensive work that has already been completed.

Update on the Environmental Remediation: May 23 to November 23, 2022

Over the past six months, Roche:

- Received NJDEP approval of Groundwater Remedial Action Report (RAR), followed by NJDEP issuance of Groundwater Remedial Action Permit (RAP).
- Conducted groundwater monitoring as specified in Groundwater RAR.
- Continued to make information and reports available on the Roche Nutley website (www.roche-nutley.com).
- Continued LNAPL gauging in MW-28 LNAPL (light non-aqueous phase liquid) area.

Over the next six months, Roche plans to:

- Continue to monitor groundwater in accordance with Groundwater RAR.
- Continue LNAPL gauging in MW-28 area.
- Continue to make information and reports available on the website (www.roche-nutley.com), including the schedule for off-site groundwater sampling.
- Submit Remedial Investigation Report (RIR)/Remedial Action Report (RAR) for MW-28 LNAPL area.
